Dear Parishioners,

What a great Celebration was had for the Feast of St Michael and All Angels last Sunday. Thank you to all who contributed to the festivities in any way, especially by being there!

I saw the Spinal Surgeon on Monday and this coming Thursday, 13th October, I will have surgery at Epworth hospital, Box Hill. All going well, I will be off work for 2 weeks after which I hope to slowly return to duties.

I am to have a Laminectomy and I found this explanation helpful.

Laminectomy is surgery that creates space by removing bone spurs and tissues associated with arthritis of the spine. It usually involves removing a small piece of the back part (lamina) of the small bones of the spine (vertebrae). Laminectomy enlarges the spinal canal to relieve pressure on the spinal cord or nerves.

On Sunday 16th October Fr Alan Jarrad will lead the worship and on Sunday 23rd October Fr David Still will lead the worship. Hopefully I will be back on deck for the 30th October.

It was my plan to get underway with annual meetings this month but they will have to wait now until November—Dates to be advised in due course.

Thankyou all for your kindness in word, thoughts and prayers through this time for both Sue and me.
