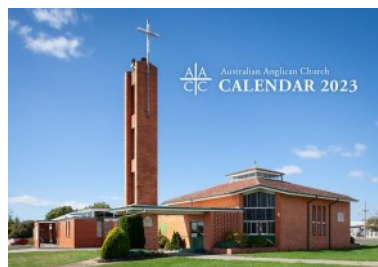
### Australian Anglican Church Calendar 2023

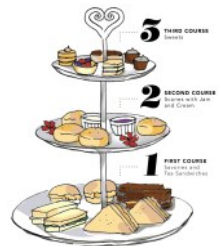
**Artisan Market—Saturday 5th November.**
