# FIRST SUNDAY AFTER EPIPHANY THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD JANUARY 8TH 2023

## Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord which as a 'stand alone Commemoration' has only been a feature of our Worship Cycle for a bit over 50 years, so pretty new really. This can be seen most clearly in the absence of special hymns for the Feast until the 1970's (see today's Gradual Hymn, written in 1977). Before The Baptism of Our Lord was separated out on its own it was part of the celebration of Epiphany.

[Epiphany is Greek word and literally means 'light around' but for us has the meaning of 'manifestation' as in the light shining from Jesus shows us who he is].

Epiphany had three elements way back in the 'old days' (the 300's) they were: first manifestation of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, represented by the Magi, and the manifestation of his divinity, as it occurred at his baptism in the Jordan River and at his first miracle, at Cana in Galilee.

These three elements plus some others now make up our commemoration of Jesus's Manifestation to the world. To assist us to continue to celebrate the great mystery of God Coming Among Us as a Human, I propose that the Crib continue to be displayed until February 2nd which is 40 Days after Christmas and a fitting completion to the Christmass Celebration.

Joyous Epiphany to all.


