February 14th. **Saints Cyril and Methodius,** were blood brothers and were born in Thessalonica (modern Salonika), Greece. Cyril, whose true name was Constantine, was born in 827, and Methodius, whose name was Michael, was born about 815. They received the names Cyril and Methodius when they became monks. Though both brothers spoke Greek, they also knew the Slavonic language because many Macedonian Slavs lived in their area. After studies at Constantinople (today's Istanbul), Methodius accepted a government position in a Slavonic-speaking area, and Cyril taught philosophy. Methodius then entered a monastery on Mount Olympus, and in about 855 Cyril joined him. In 862, when Ratislav, the Duke of Greater Moravia (now part of the Czech Republic), requested missionaries capable of instructing the Slavs in their own language, Cyril, who had been ordained a priest, and Methodius were chosen for the task. In preparation for their mission, Cyril invented an alphabet (Glagolithic script) and translated the Gospels and the liturgical books into what is now known as Old Church Slavonic. Because the brothers used Slavonic and not Latin in the liturgy, they ran into difficulty with the Bavarian priests in that same area, but when the brothers went to Rome (867 or 868), Pope Hadrian II (867–72) approved their use of the Slavonic liturgy. Cyril died in Rome on February 14, 869. Methodius was then consecrated archbishop of Sirmium (today's Sremska Mitrovica, Yugoslavia), and he returned to Moravia to continue his missionary work. He died at Velehrad (in today's Czech Republic) on April 6, 884. SS. Cyril and Methodius are honoured as the Apostles of the Slavs, and in 1980 Pope John Paul II proclaimed them co-patrons of Europe. They are also acknowledged as the fathers of Slavonic literature, because of their invention of the Slavonic alphabet and their translation of parts of the Bible.


