THE FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT. MARCH 19TH 2023

Due to work being carried out on the rail line at Glenrowan by Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC), accompanied by much noise, it was decided to not hold a worship service at St Paul's today, 19th March.

Joseph, St, the spouse of the BVM. He figures prominently in the two Infancy narratives of the Gospels—in Mt. 1–2 and to a less extent in Lk. 1–2. Both state that Mary was 'betrothed' to him at the time of the Lord's birth, but both emphasize her virginity. He was a pious Jew of Davidic descent but of humble situation, and acc. to Mt. 13:55 a carpenter. Christ grew up in his household at Nazareth for at least 12 years. Afterwards Joseph is mentioned only once by name in the NT (Lk. 4:22; cf. Mt. 13:55, Mk: 6:3), but he is often referred to in later traditions. In the 'Book of James' he is said to have been very old at the time of his marriage to Mary; and as a pattern of holiness he is the subject of various legends. The special veneration of St Joseph seems to have originated in the East, where the apocryphal 'History of Joseph the Carpenter' (4th-7th cents.) enjoyed considerable popularity. It developed comparatively late in the Western Church, though a commemoration is mentioned in the Irish Félire of St Oengus, dated to the 9th cent. Among the earliest promoters of his cult are St Bernardino of Siena and John Gerson in the 15th cent., who laid its theological foundations by drawing out the implications of his office as foster-father of Jesus, and whose teaching found liturgical expression in the introduction of his feast into the Roman Calendar in 1479. The devotion was popularized esp. by St Teresa of Ávila and St Francis de Sales. In 1714 Clement XI composed a special office for his feast, and in 1729 Benedict XIII inserted his name in the Litany of the Saints. He was declared 'Patron of the Universal Church' by Pius IX in 1870. His pre-eminent sanctity, which places him next to the BVM among the saints, was confirmed by Leo XIII in his encyclical 'Quanguam pluries' of 1889. In 1962 the name of St Joseph was added to the list of saints in the Canon of the Roman Mass (now the First Eucharistic Praver).

St Joseph is invoked as the patron of a good death; the month of March and each Wednesday used to be dedicated to him.

He is usually represented with the Child Jesus and a lily or staff. Feast day in Eastern Church, the first Sunday after Christmas.

ANNUNCIATION, the feast, observed on 25 March ('Lady Day'), commemorates the announcement of the Incarnation by the angel Gabriel to the Virgin and the conception of Christ in her womb (Lk. 1:26–38). The date is usually taken to depend on that of Christ's nativity (25 Dec.), though a different tradition held that the dependence was the other way round, and associated the date of the Lord's conception with that of His crucifixion.
