Sixteenth Sunday after Pentecost 17th September 2023

Hello Parishioners.

Hay fever and colds seem to be the order of the season! We pray that things will settle down soon for all who are suffering.

At the meeting of Parish Council on Sunday last the matter of the distribution of Communion was revisited, as has been our custom since late last year when the Common Cup was once more permitted to be used. On 22 November 2022 Bishop Clarence wrote to the Clergy about this matter, saying in part

In my letter of 16 December 2021 (12/21) I asked Parishes to make their own decisions about the administration of Holy Communion, as using a common cup was then no longer prohibited under health regulations. As most things have returned to normal, I am again urging all clergy, together with their Parish Council members and congregations, to please return to the normal way of conducting our services, including the Common Cup. People will always have a right to receive in only one kind if they choose to do so, but under no circumstances must people be allowed to dip the wafer into the chalice or receive the wafer on their tongue.

And again on 3rd March 2023 <u>Methods of Communion during and post Covid</u>
There are three methods which I have approved and have asked Clergy & PC's to discuss what will work best for them.

(a) The Common Cup (b) By intinction / dipped by the Priest only (in whatever format) or (c) to receive in the Eucharist in one kind.

Parish Council have decided that we would return to the Common Cup for all, with Communicants who are uncomfortable taking the Common Cup to receive in only one kind.

Trying to remember who will receive the cup and who wants the priest to Intinct is too confusing for the Priest (particularly this one) so we will adopt what is now the general practise around this Diocese.
