Dear Parishioners,

This week we have one of the BIG commemorations in our Calendar, **The Annunciation to The Blessed Virgin Mary**. This commemorates when the angel Gabriel visited a young Jewish woman named Mary and announced to her that she was to bear a son who would be the Saviour of the World (Jesus or Joshua = the Lord is salvation).

So significant was this event that when the calendar system of Anno Domini (AD) was first introduced by Dionysius Exiguus in AD 525, he assigned the beginning of the new year to 25 March since, according to Christian theology, the era of grace began with the Incarnation of Christ.

In England, the feast of the Annunciation came to be known as **Lady Day**, and Lady Day marked the beginning of the English new year until 1752. In England they left it as the start of the Tax Year and with the addition of 11 days with the introduction of the Gregorian Calendar, March 25 became April 6 and this is still the start of the Tax Year in England.

Within our church, **Lady Day** has a special place in the life of The Mother's Union and is often the occasion for a big gathering of members. This year in our Diocese instead of 1 big gathering there are 2 smaller gatherings at Wodonga (Saturday 22nd) and Nagambie (Tuesday 25th).
